Updated Self-Assessment Tool

The Safeguarding Committee have met to discuss our first draft of the updated self assessment tool. Fundamentally, we are well placed with evidence but there are a range of new areas where we have identified information / procedures to update / implement.

Before the end of the year, the Safeguarding Committee will complete the Commission for Children and Young People's 'Understanding cultural safety for Aboriginal children and young people' tool. Well informed practice for supporting our Indigenous community is an increased part of the self assessment tool. For our Parish, we can also use this tool as the basis of our practice for other marginalised groups.
