Parish Risk Assessments

The Safeguarding Committee undertook a risk assessment on the concrete area in the school / parish car park.

- There are nine 'concrete squares' that have broken or loose concrete.
- This is an ongoing problem as apparently the area wasn't concreted to car park standard as it wasn't previously used for that purpose.
- Additionally, South East Water alerted the school that the downpipes from the church and the school are old and are contributing to the problem.
- Signs have been put up alerting people to walk carefully and look out for the broken concrete.
- An email has been sent to school families and a note will be included in the parish newsletter.
- Options for a temporary and permanent solution will be sourced.
- Any permanent solutions may have to wait until St Columba Primary School hears in June 2024 if they were successful in their Major Works Application.

We have undertaken risk assessments for the Parish BBQ and Community Christmas Carols Concert.
